About 20 kms. from Bhaganbigha campus, Hilsa campus has also been developed by the Foundation to provide a peaceful academic atmosphere amidst rural surroundings. Hilsa campus is about 60 kms. from Patna.

CLINICAL FACILITIES

Clinical practice for the students is provided in 'Parent Hospital', Ranjay Emergency Hospital, Govt. PHCs and other private hospitals. All the hospitals have bed occupancy of more than 90%. The institute provides its own vehicle to trainee students for attending their clinical practice training. Community training is imparted in villages in blocks close to the institute Rahui and Harnaut.



LIBRARY

A well equipped library having latest editions of nursing text books from both Indian and foreign writers are available. Books in both Hindi and English languages are available in the library. For better comprehension of subjects/topics by students from rural and Hindi background, nursing books in Hindi medium have been specially purchased. Text books are liberally supplemented with reference books, national/international nursing journals and also fiction books. The library is equipped with computer with internet facility and photocopier machine which are free and open for all students and teachers. The college annually purchases books for adding to its stock of books in the library.



TRANSPORT

ADMISSION PROCESS ::

Admission in any of the course offered by the institute is done on the basis of the merit list of the written test and counseling conducted by the Institute.

- No student can claim right of admission just by submitting the application form or appearing in the entrance test.
- All students must appear in the written test and counseling for the purpose of admission in any course.
- Admission of 'Waiting List' students would only be confirmed when someone whose admission was already confirmed but does not turn up for admission or withdraws admission.
- Students in the 'Waiting List' of the merit list may be moved for admission in the next academic session, as per management's decision. The Management's decision in such case will be final.
- Criteria for admission shall be strictly according to guidelines of INC, New Delhi; Bihar Nursing Registration council and Directorate, Health Services, Govt. of Bihar and; may change from time to time as per decision/instruction of apex bodies.



Following documents are required at the time of admission:

- Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Certificate)
- Certificate and mark sheet of 10+2 or equivalent examination
- School Leaving Certificate (SLC) / Migration Certificate
- Aadhar Card of the student
- Caste Certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC) from competent authority
- Four coloured passport size photographs

Cancellation of Admission:

1. Selected candidates will have to submit their original certificates for verification. Admission will be cancelled if documents are found false.
2. Admission may be cancelled if a student pay the fee but fail to join the institute on prescribed time. In that case, all deposited fee shall be forfeited.
3. Student may also be rusticated from the Institute, anytime during the course period; if it is found that he/she has taken admission by submitting false documents. In that case, all deposited fee shall be forfeited.
4. It is the candidate's/guardian's responsibility to see that he/she has the required qualification for admission in the applied course. In case any lacunae/false information/hiding of facts is found after admission and the affiliating body denies/rejects the student's enrolment, the Institute shall not be responsible for any direct or indirect loss to students and the fee already deposited shall be forfeited.

CURRICULUM LAB : As per Regulations 2014, laboratories required for different school subjects - Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Math, Geography, etc. have been amalgamated into one curriculum lab. College's curriculum lab has aids & equipments for all school subjects for demonstrative practice of its students. Teacher educators use these aids in practice of teaching in schools where they go for practice teaching/internship.



ICT RESOURCE CENTRE : ICT Resource Centre (Lab) of the college provides opportunities to teacher educators in fine tuning their teaching skills with the help of modern technologies of communication like computer, internet, TV, OHP, etc. College's ICT lab is well equipped with such equipments & aids and both teachers and students use them for guidance and teaching practice.

HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION RESEARCH CENTRE : The college has a spacious resource centre for health and physical education. It possesses varied aid & equipments for health education for topics like nutrition, diet, vitamin deficiencies. Yoga education and training is also imparted in the centre. Charts and instruction booklets on yoga are available. Yoga instructor of the college gives vital inputs about yoga and also trains students.

ART & CRAFT RESOURCE CENTRE : Art & craft resource centre provides learning as well as practice opportunities to students of the college in various form of arts including fine arts like drawing, sketching & painting, soft toys making, embroidery, etc. and performing art such as music. Availability of musical instruments like harmonium, table, jhal, dholak, etc. provide not only its playing skills but also practice the art form and also for use in various cultural programmes of the college.

COMPUTER LAB : Computer lab of the college is equipped with 20 computers, scanner, printer and photocopier. It also provides internet facility for teaching-learning of its students. Both teachers and students avail facilities of the computer lab during college hours.

LIBRARY : A well equipped library having latest editions of text books and reference books are available. Books in both Hindi and English languages are available in the library. For better comprehension of subjects/topics by students from rural and Hindi background, books in Hindi medium have been specially purchased. Text books are liberally supplemented with reference books, NCTE and national/international journals and also fiction books. The library is equipped with computer with internet facility and photocopier machine which are free and open for all students and teachers. Both Hindi and English newspapers are subscribed and available in the library. The college annually purchases books for adding to its stock of books in the library.

PRACTICE TEACHING / INTERNSHIP : The college management has got permission of District Education Officer (DEO), Nalanda for sending its students in various govt. schools for practice teaching as per the norms of different teacher training courses run by the college, namely, M. Ed., B. Ed. and D. El. Ed. Both middle and high schools are included in the list so that trainee students get opportunity to practice teaching to children of different age-groups/maturity level in different classes. Supportive supervision and guidance to trainee teachers (students of the college) is provided by teachers of the college who accompany them in internship programme. Headmaster/In-charge of the school is also involved in scheduling & guiding them in their practice teaching. Normally a group of 5 students are assigned a particular school at a time.



B. ED. (BACHELOR OF EDUCATION)



B.Ed. is a professional course that prepares teachers for upper primary or middle level (classes VI-VIII), secondary (classes IX-X) and senior secondary (classes XI-XII) levels.

Gautam Teachers Training College is recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for B. Ed. course with an annual intake of 200 students.

The college is affiliated to Magadh University, Bodh Gaya (College Code: 444).

DURATION

Duration of B. Ed. course is of two (02) years. As per NCTE Regulations 2014, it can be completed in three academic years from the date of admission in the course.

Minimum 80% attendance in course work and 90% attendance in school internship is required for appearing in university examination.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN B. ED. COURSE

Minimum 50% marks either in Bachelor's degree and/or Master's degree in Science/Social Science/Humanities or any other equivalent qualification.

ADMISSION

Admission in B. Ed. course of the College is done on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the 'Joint Entrance Test' organized by Magadh University, Bodh Gaya; the Affiliating Body of the College.

PROCESS OF ADMISSION

- Magadh University, the Affiliating Body announces and invites application from eligible candidates for appearing in the 'Entrance Test' through advertisements in newspapers and university's website.
- Application Form for 'Entrance Test' is made available at designated colleges/offices of Magadh University.
- All students aspiring to take admission in B. Ed. course in any college of Magadh University must apply and appear in the Entrance Test.
- The university prepares and publishes the 'Merit List', as per the marks obtained by the students appearing in the entrance test. It includes the 'qualifying/ cut-off' marks for different category of students like General, SC/ST, OBC, etc.
- Students securing qualifying marks in the entrance test may appear in counseling for admission in any college of their choice.
- A student qualifying in the entrance test is free to take admission in any constituent or affiliated college of Magadh University on the condition that his/her admission is confirmed in the counseling of that college.



1. Any student seeking admission in B. Ed. course must pass 'Admission Entrance Test' organized by the University. No student can take admission without qualifying the 'Entrance Test'.
2. Student qualifying entrance test of other university cannot take admission in the College. He/she must pass the entrance test of Magadh University to become eligible for admission in Gautam Teachers Training College.

Note: Criteria/Process of admission may change from time to time as per regulation/instruction of Magadh University or any other competent authority.

IMPORTANT :: As per NCTE Rules, any student cannot take admission in any other course while doing B. Ed. Course. It is strictly prohibited to sit for/appear in any examination of any University or Board after admission in B. Ed. Programme. The admission will be cancelled with immediate effect if any candidate is found guilty. An employed candidate will have to submit the releasing/leave order from head of the concerned organization at the time of admission.

B. ED. COURSE

B. Ed. course is broadly divided into three curricular areas:-

1. Perspective in Education (Foundation Course)
2. Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies
3. Engagement with the field

SCHOOL INTERNSHIP

There will be 20 weeks of school internship in two-year B. Ed. course:-

1. Four (04) weeks in the First Year and
2. 16 weeks in the Second Year



M. ED. (MASTER OF EDUCATION)



M. Ed. is a professional programme in the field of teacher education which aims at preparing teacher educators and other education professionals including curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, planners, administrators, supervisors, school principals and researchers. Completion of the course leads to M. Ed. degree with specialization either in elementary education (upto class VIII) or in secondary/senior secondary education (classes VI XII).

Gautam Teachers Training College is recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for M. Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students and affiliated to Magadh University, Bodh Gaya.

DURATION

Duration of M. Ed. course is two (02) years including field attachment of minimum four (04) weeks and research dissertation. The course may be completed in three academic years from the date of admission in the course. The summer vacation may be utilized for field attachment/ practical/other activities.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN M. ED. COURSE

Any person seeking admission in M. Ed. course must have passed with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade in any of the following courses:-

1. B.Ed.
2. B.A.B.Ed. / B.Sc.B.Ed.
3. B.El.Ed.
4. D.El.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each)

Admission

Admission in M. Ed. course of the College is done on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the 'Joint Entrance Test' organized by Magadh University, Bodh Gaya.

Process of Admission

Process of Admission in M.Ed. course is same as that of B. Ed. course, i.e. by qualifying the 'Joint Entrance Test' organized by Magadh University.

D. El. Ed. (Diploma in Elementary Education)

D. El. Ed. course prepares teachers for elementary stage of education (classes I to VIII).

Gautam Teachers Training College is recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for D. El. Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students. Bihar School Examination Board, Patna is the Affiliating Body of the College for D. El. Ed. course.

Duration : Duration of D. El. Ed. course is two (02) years. The course may be completed in three academic years from the date of admission in the course.

Eligibility for Admission in D. El. Ed. course : Minimum 50% marks in Intermediate (+2) or its equivalent examination. Eligibility criteria may be changed as per regulations of the recognizing/affiliating body as changed from time to time.

Admission : Admission in D. El. Ed. course is done on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the 'Entrance Test' organized by the College.

Process of Admission

1. Gautam Teachers Training College invites application from eligible candidates for appearing in the 'Entrance Test' through advertisements in newspapers.
2. All students aspiring to take admission in D. El. Ed. course must apply and appear in the Entrance Test.
3. The entrance test is organized in either of the two campuses of the Group, Bhaganbigha and Hilsa.
4. A merit list is prepared on the basis of marks obtained by students in the entrance test.
5. Students qualifying in the entrance test are called for counseling in the college premises.
6. Students in the 'waiting list' are given option to take admission in D. El. Ed. course in other teacher training colleges, run by Gautam Group of Institutions.

But, with development of economies worldwide, the labour market has become more specialized. Demand of high level of skills both in govt. and private sector has increased manifold. Vocational training prepares individuals for jobs that are based on manual or practical activities. It enables to adapt to job assignments more easily and at a much faster rate. It also serves the social objective by providing opportunity to school drop-outs/semi literates and youths from socio-economically weaker sections of society. Working professionals also hone skills for their career development.

ITIs serve an important purpose of catering to the needs of vocational education & training to youths. Gautam Industrial Training Institute (GITI) ensures promotion of quality vocational training and enhancing employment and self employment opportunities. At the same time, it helps government in saving additional expenditure on establishing & developing such training institutes.

ESTABLISHMENT

Gautam Industrial Training Institute is the oldest professional education & training institute of Gautam Group of Institutions. It is established in 2010. It is recognized by NCVT (National Council for Vocational Training) and affiliated to DGET (Director General of Employment & Training) as per affiliation order DGET-6/4/23/2011-TC. The Institute is approved by Directorate of Employment & Training, Department of Labour Resources, Govt. of Bihar. Education & Training in GITI started from session 2011.

LOCATION

Gautam Industrial Training Institute is running in Bhaganbigha campus of Gautam Group of Institutions. The institute has two large and separate workshops for electrician and fitter trades being offered. Both workshops are fitted with latest machinery & equipments for practical





of its students. Different types of AC/DC motors, Shunt generator, compound generator, armature, control panels, drill machines, soldering irons, etc. and domestic electric appliances of normal use like fans, electric iron, heater, geyser, AC, Mixer-Grinder, etc. are available in the Electrician trade workshop for practical of students. Similarly, Fitter trade workshop has lathe machines, angle plates, drills, machine vices, pipe vices, chisels, scrappers, anvils, micrometers, vernier calipers, screw guaze, working bench, etc. for practical in fitter trade. All machines, equipments and tools comply with the norms of DGT as prescribed for training of respective trades of electrician and fitter. In addition, each student is provided with separate kit of tools & equipments for their regular/everyday use in practical classes.

Safety of trainee students during practical classes is paramount for the institute. The institute possesses common safety equipments as well as individual safety aids which are provided to every students during practical classes. Common safety equipments include water type fire extinguishers, dry chemical fire extinguishers and CO₂ fire extinguishers. The institute has own motor & water tank for 24-hour water supply. Individual safety aids available for trainees and instructors include helmets, leather apron, goggles, gloves, boots, etc. Each practical class and student is closely guided & monitored by instructors and lab attendants for proper training and safety of trainee students.

LIBRARY

A well equipped library having latest editions of text books and reference books are available. Books in both Hindi and English languages are available in the library. For better comprehension of subjects/topics by students from rural

and Hindi background, books in Hindi medium have been specially purchased. Text books by NIMI and from other publications, based on NIMI publication, as per the prescribed syllabus, are available in the library. Text books are liberally supplemented with reference books and also fiction books. The library is equipped with computer and photocopier and is open for all students and teachers. Both Hindi and English newspapers are subscribed and available in the library. The institute annually purchases books for adding to its stock of books in the library.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT) LAB

IT lab of the institute is equipped with 15 computers, scanner, printer and photocopier. Internet facility for teaching-learning and availing external, national/international resource material both by students and teachers is provided through wi-fi. Both teachers and students avail facilities of the IT lab during institute's working hours.

PRACTICAL TRAINING / INTERNSHIP

The management of the institute has made arrangement with local industries, service centres, etc. for practice training of its students. MOUs and agreements are signed with such centres which allow use of their services by students of the institute for practice training of their respective trades. It provides trainee students opportunity to practice their learnt trade in actual work settings. Supportive supervision and guidance to trainees is provided by instructors of the institute who accompany them in such practice training programmes. Manager/In-charge of training centres is also involved in scheduling & guiding trainees in their practice training. Normally a group of 5-6 trainees are assigned a particular centre at a time.



GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS OF GAUTAM GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS

 - vii. Writing on walls, bathrooms/toilets, furniture or black board (without permission) is banned.
 - viii. Verbal or physical harassment to any other student or staff.
 - ix. Aimlessly loitering around in the campus.
 8. No function/activity will be organized/arranged by the students without prior permission of the Principal/Warden.
 9. Eating snacks/taking lunch inside the class rooms, library, laboratories is not permitted.
 10. Students are not permitted to use college telephone.
 11. Students will have to pay for any damage done by them to Institute/Trust property inside or outside the campus.
 12. Illness or minor ailments must be reported to the Principal/Warden as early as possible.
 13. The Institution is not responsible if any student leaves the campus without authorized permission. The Institution will also be not responsible if the student indulges in any unlawful activity or any unfortunate mishap/accident happens to the student, on his/her visit, outside the campus.
 14. The Management reserves the right to increase any fees at any time and the Management is not answerable for the same.
 15. All communication to the Institute should be addressed to the Principal.
 16. The decision of the Principal/Management in any type of complaint/dispute will be final and binding on the students.

- TERMINATION FROM INSTITUTE AS DISCIPLINARY**



ACTION:

- a) Students may be terminated from the Institute for disobedience and violation of the rules & regulations prescribed by the competent authorities of the Institute or,

GENERAL RULES FOR LIBRARY

1. Silence must be observed in the library.
2. Library facilities can be utilized by students and staffs during institute hours on working days.
3. Books cannot be issued to a student without the library card.
4. A student can borrow a maximum of four books at a time from the library.
5. Normally a book will be issued for Fifteen (15) days.
6. Book borrowed from library should be returned on or before due date, If not, penalty will be charged from the student. Issue of same book may be renewed after depositing it on or before due date.
7. Books should be handled carefully. If a book is lost by any student, he/she will replace the book (same title, author and edition) or will pay double the cost of the book as fine.
8. No one is permitted to write in, underline, fold or tear pages or deface the book in any manner whatsoever.
9. If anyone (student/staff) finds, after issue of the book, that page(s) of the issued book is torn/ damaged/ defaced, etc. he/she should report it to the librarian before taking the book out of the library. Otherwise,

he/she will be held responsible for the damage and penalty would be charged from him.

10. Book issued in one's name will not be transferred in any other's name.
11. Students will have to return books and the library card and; get 'NO DUE CERTIFICATE' from the librarian before filling of their examination form.
12. Similarly, the staff members who intend to leave the institution should get 'NO DUE CERTIFICATE' from the librarian before settlement of their accounts with the institution.

As per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order -

“If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her.”

1. Accordingly, ragging is illegal and completely prohibited and banned both inside and outside the Institute, hostel or campus.
2. If any student is caught or named by the victim student or his/her parents/guardians, an FIR will be lodged against the student (culprit).
3. Strict action leading to termination of admission and rustication from the institution would be taken against any ragging complaint and decision of the Management would be final & binding to the student(s).
4. Parent/Guardians are also advised to counsel their ward to neither engage in any sort of ragging activity nor incite any other student to do so.
